Care Sheet Black Dwarf Mulberry - Morus nigra

Origin: Asia

General info

Semi-deciduous dwarf tree ever bearing fruit. Zone 7-9 indoor in winter

Over Wintering

Before freezing temperatures bring bonsai into house and place in half day or better sun. Tree may lose part or all of its leaves if warm enough tree will sprout new growth and continue to grow or you can let the frost kill the leaves and store the dormant tree in a cool place 35-50F keeping moderately moist

Lighting

Outside part to half day sun. Indoor half day of sun or better can add artificial light if needed

Watering

When soil is dry on top. When you water make sure you completely wet all the soil in the pot every time you water. Don't pour in a little water every day.

Feeding

Spring thru fall. You can use house plant or nursery fertilizers. Follow the label for rates and application times.

Training

Major pruning is done in winter when dormant or semi dormant. Pinching and some leaf removal done throughout summer

Repotting

Every year in spring before new growth starts
